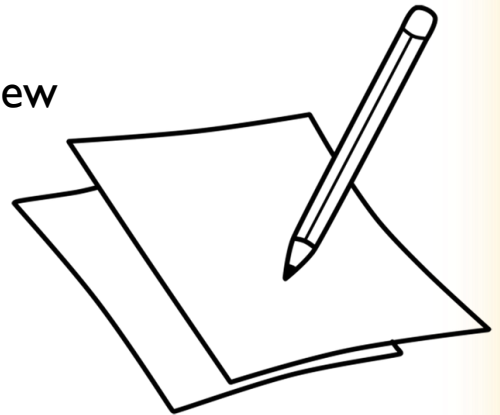


ARCHAEOLOGY & ETHNOGRAPHY ACTIVITY:

Instructions

Archaeology Activity:

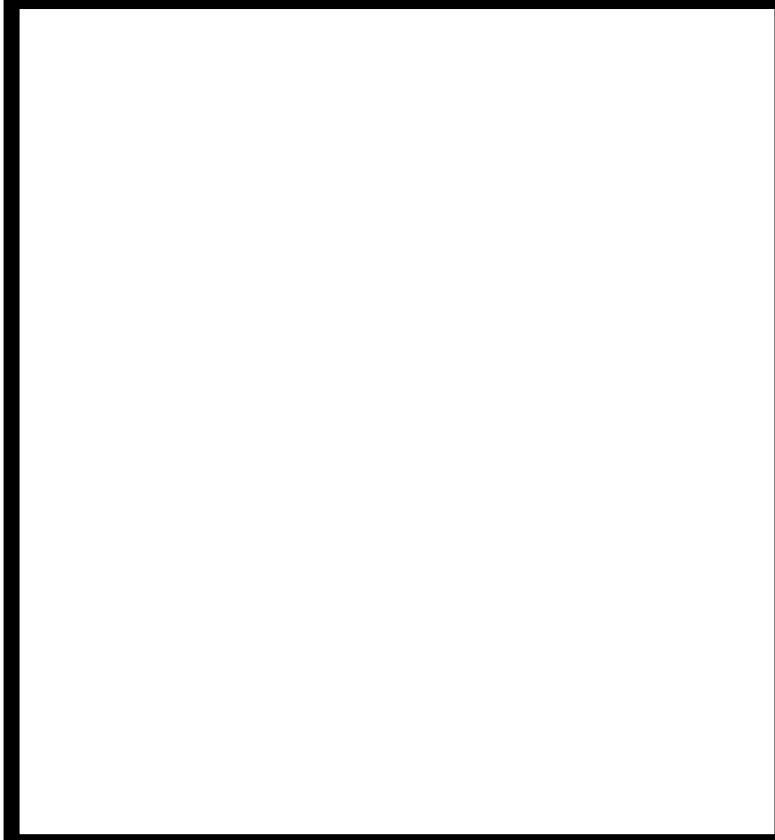
